Ex. #1 - These categories are like a spiral staircase rather than steps on a ladder. They are all interconnected - thus the relationship of aromas to colors to sound. This is where we can create harmony among the frequencies.







Double Resonance for G

Keys to play to match the resonance of the room and the mood of the patient
If the room resonance (machines etc) is:

C – play either GM (outreaching) or Gm (reflective)

C# - (this is one of the harder combinations) you can play DM (outreaching) and accent the G but it isn't all that satisfying. Bm (reflective) works the best with the G accented and then matching the machine with the C#. You can also create a haunting melody if you have 4 flats and can play in the key of Db.

D – play either GM(outreaching) or Gm (reflective) and accent the D

D#/Eb – play Gm (reflective) or EbM (outreaching) and accent the G

E – play either GM (outreaching) or Em (reflective) and accent the G

F – G mixolydian (dreamy) (I would use this as a cross between either major and minor. Again, we have an odd combination here.

F# - play DM (outreaching) accenting the G or Em (reflective) accenting the F# and G

G –GM (outreaching), Gm (reflective), G mixolydian (dreamy)

G#/Ab – play in key of Eb (Bb,Eb,Ab) (outreaching) and accent the G or in Cm (Bb,Eb, Ab) (reflective and accent the G

A – play either DM (outreaching) or D Mixolydian (dreamy) starting on the A and going to the G as an alternate chord.

A#/Bb – play either BbM (Bb, Eb) Outreaching, accent the G or Gm (Bb, Eb) reflective

B – play either GM (outreaching) or Em (reflective) and accent the G



5b. Understanding how intervals affect mood is essential. Each interval that the harpist plays delivers a message.
